If you have detected bed bugs by using the products below, being bitten or observing bed bugs, bed bug eggs or excrement in mattress tufts and bedding, you want to choose from one or more of the following product types depending on your needs:

- Use an aerosol product registered to treat bed bugs and bed bug eggs in cracks and crevices.
- Use a ready-to-use liquid product registered to treat bed bugs and bed bug eggs for spot treatment.

CÓMO USAR

Para aplicar el tratamiento de chinches de cama y sus huevos a las camas: Desarme el armazón de la cama y retire la ropa de cama. No aplique el producto a la ropa de cama. Aplique este producto al armazón de la cama, el colchón y el box spring. La aplicación a colchones y box springs está dirigida a tratar las costuras, bordes, grietas, pliegues y agujeros de ventilación solamente. No sature el colchón o el box spring. No trate toda la superficie del colchón o el box spring. Permita que el rocío se seque antes de usar el colchón y/o el box spring. Además, aplique el producto a grietas y rajaduras en el dormitorio tales como los bordes inferiores, detrás de cuadros, tapices y colgantes, a lo largo y debajo de los bordes de las alfombras y a otros artículos o muebles en el dormitorio o la zona de dormir.
