About Your ReptoHabitat

Please read carefully prior to setting up your ReptoHabitat.

1. Choose your location carefully.

Always place the ReptoHabitat in a location designed to support its total weight. NOTE: filled with water, gravel, and decorations, a ReptoHabitat can weigh more than 10 pounds per gallon.

Always place the ReptoHabitat on a flat, level, water-resistant surface. Stands 13" wide or less should be anchored or tethered to a wall to provide stability.

Never place in direct sunlight. Full or partial sunlight can cause excessive algae growth in aquatic habitats. Sunlight can also cause the temperature inside the habitat to rise to unsafe levels for your pet.

Never place near a heating or air conditioning vent.

Never place ReptoHabitat on top of a TV or electrical device, or in an entertainment center.

2. Handle with care

Always grasp and carry the ReptoHabitat from underneath, supporting the bottom at all times.

Never try to move a full or partially full ReptoHabitat.

Never lift a ReptoHabitat by grasping its upper frame.

Never lift a ReptoHabitat with wet hands.

3. When setting up your ReptoHabitat

Always rinse gravel, rocks, and ornaments thoroughly before placing into tank.

Always treat (dechlorinate) water before adding to your aquarium. Do not add plain tap water—it can harm your pet.

Always fill ReptoHabitat with room-temperature water. Cool water causes condensation, which can cause the appearance of leakage.

Never place heat lamps directly against the glass. Heat lamps should be positioned to shine through the Screen Top.

Screen Top instructions

The included Screen Top has been engineered for easy access to your habitat.

To insert Screen Top:

1. Make sure the front handle and side latches are not engaged. Rotate the main handle clockwise until it stops. Rotate the two side latches so the triangles on the knobs are pointing toward the middle of the Screen Top.
2. Grasp the handle on top of the screen with one hand and place the back onto the back edge of the habitat frame.
3. Slide the screen back until the lip that runs along the back edge catches on the back lip of the habitat frame.
4. Tilt the screen down flat on the top of the habitat.
5. Gently rotate the front main handle counter-clockwise until the padlock loop on the handle meets the padlock loop on the screen. Your Screen Top is now secured to your reptile enclosure.
6. For extra security, engage the two side latches by turning in either direction until they stop.

To remove Screen Top:

1. If you have engaged the side latches, rotate both so the triangular extensions on the knobs are pointing toward the middle of the Screen Top.
2. Grasp the handle on top of the screen with one hand and gently rotate clockwise until the latch releases from the frame.
3. Tilt the screen upward and pull gently toward the front of the habitat to release.
4. Remove.
